

Sir Joseph Banks High School

Works notification | 19 May 2025

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, a project is underway to upgrade Sir Joseph Banks High School to provide brand new modern facilities, refurbishment of existing school buildings and landscaping across the existing school.

Site investigation works from 22 May to 31 May 2025

Site investigations and geotechnical work will be carried out on the school grounds to obtain information on ground conditions to help inform the next phase of the project.

Preparation for this work will start on Thursday, 22 May, from 2 pm to 6 pm, with the main work planned for Saturday 24 and Saturday 31 May, from 8 am to 4 pm.

The work will involve surveying the site, digging test pits, and drilling boreholes to assess soil and rock composition. A large excavator and drill rig will be in operation on both Saturdays, generating intermittent noise.

Refer to the map on the next page for the location of the geotechnical investigation works.

There will be no disruption to traffic or pedestrian travel.
