Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Smalls Road Public School

A project is underway to build a new primary school for 1,000 students to cater for the projected enrolment growth in the area. The new school will feature a three-storey building with:

- new innovative learning spaces
- special education learning spaces
- modern core facilities including a hall, library and multipurpose sports courts.

Progress summary

The main building is in the final stages of fit out and is due for completion in mid-December.

Work on landscaping, sports courts and the carpark is also expected to be completed by mid-December.

The road works on Smalls Road, providing a kiss and drop zone to the new school, is underway and due to be completed by late December.

Next steps

Kindergarten students will start school on Monday 3 February 2020.

The school is planning an open morning to provide the local community an opportunity to visit the new facilities. More information will be provided in the new year.

Enrolments for Year 1-6 for the 2021 school year will open in 2020.
