Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is spending \$6 billion over four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools. This includes an additional \$160 million in 2018/19 as part of the record \$747 million maintenance investment announced last year. This is the biggest investment in public school infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Smalls Road new primary school

A new primary school for 1,000 students is being planned to cater for the projected enrolment growth in the area. The project will include:

- new future-focused learning spaces
- special education learning spaces
- modern core facilities.

Progress summary

The detailed design has been completed and demolition works are underway.

Next steps

A construction contractor will be appointed and we will work to minimise any disruptions across the project as much as possible. Subject to planning approvals, construction is due to start late 2018 with completion expected early 2020.
