### Project update

November 2018

#### Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is spending \$6 billion over four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools. This includes an additional \$160 million in 2018/19 as part of the record \$747 million maintenance investment announced last year. This is the biggest investment in public school infrastructure in the history of NSW.

#### Speers Point Public School

A project is underway to upgrade Speers Point Public School to cater for projected enrolment growth in the area. The project will deliver new permanent innovative learning spaces, a new hall, new administration building and new library.

The upgrade also includes the refurbishment of the existing library and classrooms into special education classrooms and amenities, as well as levelling the areas around these buildings for ease of access.

#### Progress summary

The project team are currently finalising the concept design. The upgrade will be delivered in two stages.

Early works will start in November 2018 to deliver the new special education classrooms and amenities in time for Day 1 Term 1 2019. Main works construction is expected to start in 2019.

#### Site establishment starts November

Site establishment prepares the construction area so that works can begin. We will:

- install site signage and security fencing around the work site
- deliver equipment and materials
- remove trees that are impacted by the works.

Traffic control and security measures will be in place where required for the safety of students, community and workers.

Construction work will take place Monday to Friday, 7am to 5pm and Saturdays, 8am to 1pm. No work will take place on Sundays or Public Holidays.

We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently and we will minimise impacts on the community at every opportunity.
