Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Project overview

A project is underway to upgrade Speers Point Public School. The project will provide new permanent innovative learning spaces for five classes, a new hall, a new administration building, and a new library.

A refurbishment to turn the existing library and classrooms into special education classrooms and amenities was completed in early 2019.

Progress summary

The Project Reference Group has endorsed the schematic design for the main upgrade works, and detailed designs are currently being finalised.

The existing administration building has been relocated and bulk excavation and earthworks are now complete. Works are progressing well with the pouring of concrete slabs and footings for the foundations of the new buildings underway.

Construction of the building structure and roof will commence in coming weeks.

Current activities include:

- Relocating in-ground utility services
- Pouring concrete slabs and footings for the foundations of the new buildings
- Delivery of equipment and materials.

The project is forecast for completion late 2020.

Working hours

Work will take place during approved hours between 7am and 5pm, Monday to Saturday. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays unless notified. We are here to make sure the work is completed safely and efficiently, and we will minimise impacts on the community at every opportunity.
