Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is spending \$6 billion over four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools. This includes an additional \$160 million in 2018/19 as part of the record \$747 million maintenance investment announced last year. This is the biggest investment in public school infrastructure in the history of NSW.

St Ives North Public School

An upgrade at St Ives North Public School is underway. The project will deliver new permanent innovative learning spaces and an upgrade to core facilities.

Progress summary

The project team is working closely with the stakeholders to guide the design and a construction tender will be issued soon.

A development application is being lodged in with Ku-ring-gai Council which includes the construction of a new three storey building, to accommodate new learning spaces and administration areas.

Construction

Subject to planning approvals, early works construction will commence in December 2018 and will involve:

- demolition works
- installation of temporary demountable buildings
- refurbishment of existing buildings.

The safety of our students, staff and visitors is of the highest priority. We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently and we will minimise impacts on the community at every opportunity.
