Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

St Ives North Public School upgrade

An upgrade is underway at St Ives North Public School. The project will deliver new permanent innovative learning spaces and an upgrade to core facilities.

Progress summary

The school upgrade remains on-track for completion by mid-2020.

The memorial pavers that have been created by past students have been safely stored and will be put back in place when construction has been completed.

The memorial garden is also secured safely behind the construction hoarding and will be reopened when construction has been completed.

Next steps

Work on the building's structure continues, with concrete pouring to create each storey of the new building underway.

Concrete mixer deliveries will continue via Memorial Avenue. Traffic management will be in place when necessary to secure the safety of pedestrians and vehicles

We will continue to work with the school community and neighbours to ensure that disruptions are minimised.
