Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

St Ives North Public School

An upgrade is underway for St Ives North Public School. The project will deliver new permanent, flexible teaching spaces and an upgrade of the school's core facilities.

Progress summary

The Development Application was formally approved by Ku-ring-gai Council on 19 September 2019.

Site establishment and piling works are now complete.

Services and ground works progressing.

Summer works

During the summer break, works will continue, including in-ground works with the replacement of the damaged sewer line and hydrant line diversion; ground works including excavation for the lift pits; and the installation of new boundary fencing.

Frequently asked questions

What works will be completed over the holidays?

In-ground works including the replacement of the damaged sewer line and hydrant line diversion; ground works including excavation for the lift pits; and the installation of the new boundary fencing.

What are the construction working hours?

There are no changes to works hours during the holiday period.

All works are to be completed within the Development Application hours of Monday to Friday 7:00am to 5:00pm and Saturday 8:00am to 3:00pm.

No works will take place on public holidays or Sundays.

Will construction take place over Christmas and New Year?

No works will take place on public holidays or Sundays.

What safety measures will be in place?

The site has safety management plans that will be strictly adhered to. Regular inspections will continue during the holiday period.

What steps will be taken to control noise and dust impacts?

Hoarding and shade cloth will be erected to reduce noise and dust impacts on the school and our neighbours. Dust due to any site works will be hosed down as required.

How will traffic be managed?

Traffic management will be in place where required for the safety of students, staff, the local community and workers. Traffic controllers will be used where required to manage entry and exit of vehicles to and from the construction site. Vehicles will give way to pedestrians at all times.
