Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6 billion over the next four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$847 million is being spent on school maintenance over four years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

St Ives North Public School

An upgrade at St Ives North Public School is underway. The project will deliver new permanent innovative learning spaces and an upgrade to core facilities.

Progress summary

The project team is working closely with school stakeholders to guide the design and a construction tender for early and main works has been issued.

A development application has being lodged with Ku-ring-gai Council which includes the construction of a new multi-storey building to accommodate new learning spaces and administration areas.

Summer school holiday works

Site establishment works will commence from December 2018. Site establishment will involve erecting construction fencing, delivering equipment and installing the site office and work sheds.

The installation of temporary demountables and minor internal refurbishments works will also be carried out during the holiday period.

We are here to make sure that work is completed safely and efficiently. During this time we will be working collaboratively with the school community and neighbours to ensure that disruptions to the community are minimised.

Frequently asked questions

What works will be completed over the holidays?

From December 2018 early works will commence and this will include:

- site establishment
- installation of temporary demountables
- minor internal refurbishment works

Will construction take place over Christmas and New Year?

No work will take place on public holidays or Sundays.

What steps will be taken to control noise and dust impacts?

Hoarding and shade cloth will be erected to reduce noise and dust impacts on the school and our neighbours. Dust from any early works will be hosed down as required.

How will traffic be managed?

Traffic control and security measures will be in place where required for the safety of the community.

Will use of the school hall be impacted?

No. Works will not impact use of the school hall during the school holidays.

How will you keep us informed during construction?

School infrastructure NSW will continue to share construction updates and project information as the project progresses. We will provide information through information booths, project updates, our website and school newsletters.
