Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

St Ives North Public School

An upgrade at St Ives North Public School is underway. The project will deliver new permanent innovative learning spaces and an upgrade to core facilities.

Progress summary

The development application has been approved by Ku-ring-gai Council.

Detailed design has been completed and site establishment has prepared the area for main construction works to begin.

Main construction works beginning

Main construction works are now underway. The first stage of work includes bulk earthworks and excavation.

Construction hours are 7am to 5pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.

Site hoarding has been erected to minimise noise and dust. Construction deliveries will be limited to outside peak drop-off and pick-up times wherever possible to ensure the safety of students, staff and the local community.
