Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$8.9 billion for new and upgraded schools. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world-class public education.

Project overview

In early 2021, the NSW Department of Education delivered the first stage of a new indoor sports centre at St Ives High School. The facilities include 2 multi-use courts, a school canteen, 2 modern classrooms, a fitness lab, and a seminar room.

Stage 2 of the indoor sports centre is being funded by Ku-ring-gai Council together with a \$3.5 million NSW Government grant. School Infrastructure is delivering the project on behalf of Council.

The second stage of the project will deliver a two-storey sports complex that includes 2 additional sports courts, a multipurpose room, male and female amenities, and a café. It will be built next to the facilities delivered in the first stage to provide an integrated complex of four sports courts.

The centre will be jointly operated and managed by Council and NSW Department of Education.

Progress summary

The tiered spectator seating and retaining walls for landscaping are now complete.

The major concrete pours for the building have been completed, installation of the structural steel framework is well underway and roofing works have started.

Forecast completion

The St Ives indoor sports centre was expected to open in mid 2025, however, this date has been delayed due to the additional asbestos remediation works which were required on site last year. We now expect the indoor sports centre to open in early 2026.

- Completing roof sheeting and work on the facade.
- Continuing with landscaping work.
- Installing electrical and water services.
