Progress summary

Main works are underway and Barpa, the building contractor, has recently completed the following activities:

- Bulk earthworks
- Installation of screw piles
- Detailed excavation for footings and services
- Formwork and pouring of concrete footings.

In the coming weeks, Barpa will install the formwork for ground floor slab, pour the main ground floor slab, and excavate and install the formwork for the external staircase
