The new multi-purpose hall at Stanwell Park Public School will deliver the latest facilities for students and include a canteen, out of school hours care facilities, and storage facilities.

Progress summary

- Wollongong City Council has assessed and approved the Development Application (DA) for a new multipurpose hall at Stanwell Park Public School.
- The detailed design of the new hall has been progressed by the contractor (Barpa Pty Ltd) and is nearing completion.
- Barpa Pty Ltd has started establishing the site and is managing traffic onto the site from Station Street.

Next Steps

Main works will begin in early October.

Barpa Pty Ltd will begin by demolishing the existing fencing and concrete stairs to the lower sports field and excavate the site to the required levels for the new school hall. This will be followed by piling work and installation of foundations and in-ground services.

School Infrastructure NSW (SINSW) will work closely with the school leadership team to ensure continuity of school operations and to minimise any potential impact on student learning during construction. SINSW will also continue to prepare notifications to neighbouring properties to keep them informed of the impact of school construction on the local area.

Working hours are Monday to Saturday, 7 am to 5 pm. No work will occur on Sundays or public holidays, unless otherwise advised.

All work will be within NSW Government's Public Health Orders and relevant COVID restrictions.
