Notification of works at Tamworth Public School during Term 1 holidays

As part of the upgrade to Tamworth Public School, it is necessary to undertake works this Saturday 11 April to complete roofing works on the Communal Hall.

Works on Saturday 11 April will take place between 7am and 3pm.

Other works taking place over the Term 1 holiday period within regular working hours include:

- Roof safety access installation and installation of external cladding works to the Communal Hall
- Upper floor structural steel erection, installation of external pavement areas including planter boxes and wall and ceiling sheeting on the lower floor of the teaching block

Environmental Planning and Assessment (COVID-19 Development - Construction Work Days) Order 2020

In line with the NSW Environmental Planning and Assessment (COVID-19 Development – Construction Work Days) Order 2020, School Infrastructure NSW construction sites can now operate on weekends and public holidays during the COVID-19 pandemic. This is to allow workers to abide by social distancing rules while on construction sites by distributing building work across the week.

School Infrastructure NSW will determine whether there is a need to adopt the new rule on its site depending on the stage of the project, the type of work being performed, and the number of workers required on site to complete that work. School Infrastructure NSW will notify the local community of any changes to standard construction hours for each project and will ensure work is considerate of neighbours with noise kept to a minimum.
