Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over four years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Project overview

A project is underway to upgrade Tamworth Public School. The project will provide:

- seven new permanent classrooms
- a new hall
- repurposing of existing hall to provide staff facilities
- refurbishment of existing teaching spaces to provide three practical activities areas
- refurbishment of the former teacher's cottage (Block M).

Progress summary

The concept design has been approved with the schematic design being reviewed by the projects technical stakeholders. Early works have been completed with the main works expected to begin late July.

Forecast completion is expected mid-2020.

Next steps

- award contractor for main works construction
- commencement of construction
