Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Tamworth Public School

A project is underway to upgrade Tamworth Public School. The project will provide:

- seven new permanent classrooms
- a new hall
- repurposing of existing hall to provide staff facilities
- refurbishment of existing teaching spaces to provide three practical activities areas
- refurbishment of the former teacher's cottage (Block M).

Progress summary

The Tamworth Public School upgrade is progressing well with the provision of new staff facilities and teaching spaces well underway. Groundworks have started on site and work has also started to build the

new hall and classrooms. School services have been relocated to allow the refurbishment of existing buildings.

The project is expected to be completed mid-2020.

Summer school holiday works

The site will be closed from 4:00pm Friday, 20 December 2019 until 7:00am Monday, 6 January 2020.

In early January, outside school hours care (OSHC) including Vacation Care will be relocated to the Sternbeck Building on Bourke Street. This will allow the refurbishment of Block M to commence during the summer holidays.

Over the summer school break, detailed design plans for Tamworth Public School will be finalised.

What are the construction working hours?

Construction hours over the summer school holidays will be Monday to Saturday from 7:00am to 4:00pm.

No work will take place on Sundays and Public Holidays.

Will construction take place over Christmas and New Year?

No work will be undertaken from Saturday, 21 December 2019 to Sunday, 5 January 2020 inclusive.
