Tamworth Public School

A project is underway to upgrade Tamworth Public School. The project will provide:

- seven new permanent classrooms
- a new hall
- repurposing of existing hall to provide staff facilities
- refurbishment of existing teaching spaces to provide three practical activities areas
- refurbishment of the former teacher's cottage (Block M).

Progress summary

Construction is progressing well and most buildings have reached internal fit-out stage.

Refurbishment of the teacher's cottage is complete and it is ready to be occupied.

The new communal hall building has been painted and joinery and office fit-out is continuing.

Term 2 holiday construction works

Works taking place over the Term 2 holiday period include:

- Internal fit-out for the teaching block will start and this includes joinery, painting and tiling.
- External concrete paving.
- Lift installation.
