Investing in our schools

The NSW Government's 2018/19 Budget includes \$6 billion over four years to deliver more than 170 new and upgraded schools. A further \$160 million has also been invested as part of the record \$747 million maintenance investment announced last year. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Terrigal Public School project

A project is underway to upgrade Terrigal Public School to create an innovative learning environment and to meet growing student enrollments. The project will deliver:

- Ten new adaptable and innovative learning spaces
- An upgrade of existing core facilities, including the administration building and staff and student amenities.

Progress summary

Site signage and fencing has been installed around the work area and the contractor North Construction and Building has cleared the site and started excavation. The activities that will take place over the coming months include:

- Remediation of contaminated materials
- Construction activities including bulk excavation and relocation of existing services
- Formwork and concrete pours.

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Site management during construction

During construction, the contractors will follow rigorous processes to ensure the safety of students, staff, contractors, parents and other visitors to the site is maintained. We will work closely with the Principal to minimise any disruptions across the project.

- Security fencing and hoarding has been constructed to secure the construction site.
- Throughout construction, contractors will enter the site via dedicated entryways.
- Work will take place between 7am and 5pm, Monday to Saturday. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.
- Over the Christmas and New Year period, there will be a site shut down from 5pm, Saturday 22 December 2018 to 7am, Wednesday 2 January 2019.
- Some work may be required outside of standard construction hours to safely remediate contaminated materials. The community will be informed of any changes to standard working hours.

Traffic management

- Contractor deliveries will be scheduled and will not coincide with drop off or pick up times.
- The existing kiss and drop zone will remain active throughout the project.

Remediation of contaminated materials

- The health, safety and well-being of students, staff and neighbours is our highest priority.
- Asbestos remediation will be managed in accordance with the Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan and Safe Work NSW by licensed and accredited asbestos removalists and occupational hygienists, in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.
- Notification will be provided to nearby residents and the school community prior to the start of any remediation works.
- Please be aware that the remediation of asbestos will pose no risk to staff, students or the local community.
