Progress update

The Terrigal Public School upgrade is progressing well, with construction of the new building now well underway. Currently we are finishing the construction of the new building structure and steel supports for the roof.

Pedestrian access ramp to be built over July school holidays

Over the July school holidays, we will be constructing a new pedestrian access ramp between Havenview Road and the new school building. This access ramp will replace the existing footpath that connects Havenview Road to the school, providing better access to both the new and existing school buildings (refer to map overleaf).

We will also be laying concrete on the western side of the new building to create a new paved area (near the KN and KA kindergarten classrooms). This pavement will improve access to classrooms and help to integrate the new building with the existing building.

Weather permitting, this work will start on 6 July and be completed before the start of Term 3. However, if there is significant rain over this period there is a chance that work will be delayed and the pedestrian access ramp will not be ready on day 1 of Term 3. If this occurs, we will have signs at the Havenview Road entrance indicating alternative routes for pedestrians.

Working hours

Work will take place from 7am to 5pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 5pm Saturday. No work will take place on Sundays.


