Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Project overview

- A major upgrade is underway at Terrigal Public School to improve facilities and cater for projected growth. The project will deliver:
- New flexible, permanent teaching spaces for 10 classes
- An upgrade of existing core facilities including:
 - administration
 - staff amenities and facilities
 - student amenities

Progress summary

The new building is in the final stages of fit out and is due for completion in time for students returning for Day 1 Term 1 in 2020.

During the holiday period staff will be relocated to Block L. Additional staff car parking spaces have also been provided as part of the upgrade. In addition, the demountable buildings on the campus will be removed over the summer holiday.

Next steps

Students will return to school on 29 January 2020. A welcome team will be present at the school to provide information, answer questions and to direct students to classrooms.
