

Teven-Tintenbar Public School

Works notification

December 2021

A project is underway to improve the hall facilities at Teven-Tintenbar Public School. This will include provision of communal hall space with sound system, storage facilities for sports equipment and chairs, and accessible toilets, a new covered outdoor area, a new canteen, an OSHC office, kitchenette and storeroom.

The development application (DA) was approved by Ballina Shire Council in November 2021.

Summer works

Site establishment activities for construction of the new school hall began in the week commencing Monday 7 December 2021. Installation of the temporary construction fencing, hoarding and fencing is now complete.

Over the summer holidays, work will continue on site. During this time, you can expect to see workers proceeding with vegetation removal, the installation of temporary services and groundworks. Vehicle access to the works zone will continue to be from the school entry road via Fredericks Lane.

All works on site will be undertaken in line with our development consent conditions, and all efforts will be taken to minimise impacts to the community and local residents.

Shutdown period

The worksite will be shut down between Thursday 23 December 2021 to Sunday 9 January, 2022, in line with the Christmas break. Work will resume on site on Monday 10 January, 2022.
