Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$8.6 billion in school infrastructure over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 160 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This builds on the more than \$9.1 billion invested in projects delivered since 2017, a program of \$17.7 billion in public education infrastructure.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

A project is underway to improve the hall facilities at Teven-Tintenbar Public School. This will include the provision of communal hall space with sound system, storage facilities for sports equipment and chairs, and accessible toilets, a new covered outdoor area, a new canteen, an Outside of School Hours Care (OOSH) office, kitchenette and storeroom.

Progress summary

Construction continues at Teven-Tintenbar Public School. The roof and gutters for the new hall have been installed and the bricklaying works are complete. We have installed the internal plumbing and electricity connections to the wall cavities in the process known as 'Roughing in' and fitted all internal doors and windows.

Next steps

The final phase of the project includes finishing the remaining external works, painting, and completing the internal fit outs such as installing the cabinets, lights, data ports and flooring. We will share more details about the new facilities in the coming months, as we prepare for the school and community to use them.
