The NSW Government is committed to rebuilding flood affected schools in the Northern Rivers region, ensuring we build back better with flood resilient schools for local students and local communities.

Project overview

As part of this commitment, a project is underway to rebuild Tumbulgum Public School after it was extensively damaged during floods in early 2022.

The project will deliver a raised, modern, and more flood resilient school for students and staff, with flexible classrooms, library, canteen, administration spaces, and landscaping.

Once we have finalised school designs and completed all the required information, we will submit a planning application to rebuild Tumbulgum Public School.

Connecting with Country consultation will also be held with the local community and Tweed Wollumbin Aboriginal Education Consultative Group (AECG) to ensure that the school design and daily school operations reflect the cultural heritage of the school site and local area.
