Tumbulgum Public School Works notification | 29 October 2024

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, a project is underway to rebuild Tumbulgum Public School after it was extensively damaged by floods in 2022. The project will provide new, more flood resilient school facilities for Tumbulgum Public School students and staff.

Temporary demountable building relocation

As part of preparations for the new school facilities the temporary school buildings installed after the floods will be relocated on the Tumbulgum Public School site. This includes administration, 2 classrooms, library and toilets. The site map is below.

Relocation of the temporary buildings will allow students to continue learning on their own school site while construction of the new school facilities is underway. All demountable buildings will be removed from the school site once rebuilding of Tumbulgum Public school is complete.

Preparations for the relocation of the temporary buildings have commenced, and will include:

- Installation of temporary fencing. This fencing will be removed before students start learning from the new temporary school location.
- Installation of piers and footings in preparation of the temporary buildings.
- Preliminary work for services connection.

The temporary buildings will be relocated on site during the summer school holidays and will be ready for students and staff on Day 1 Term 1 2025.

Construction of the new school will not begin until all planning approvals are in place. We will advise the community as soon as this occurs.

We will continue to keep the school community updated throughout the rebuilding of Tumbulgum Public School.
