A project is underway to upgrade Tweed Heads South Public School. The project includes new permanent learning spaces, a new library, new out of school hours care (OSHC) facilities, refurbished early learning centre (ELC), refurbishment of staff and administration areas, and improved playground and outdoor spaces.

Demolition of former OSHC building

In early August 2021, work will begin to remove the former OSHC building at Tweed Heads South Public School to make way for a new library and learning spaces to be built.

The building will be demolished in sections and it is expected to take around two weeks.

The demolition area is located away from operational areas of the school, as shown in the image overleaf, and will be fenced off to keep students, staff and visitors safe.

The building is similar in style to a demountable so demolition is not expected to be particularly dusty. Dust control measures will be in place as outlined in the project Construction Management Plan.

Heavy vehicles will enter the demolition area from Oxley Street via the site compound. Traffic controllers will be in place on Oxley Street during truck movements.

Working hours

Standard work hours will be from 7 am to 5 pm Monday to Saturday. There will be no work on Sundays or public holidays. Deliveries may occur outside of these hours but not before 6:30 am or after 6:30 pm. Any change to work hours will be notified in advance.
