Project update | December 2023

Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a historic \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

Tweed River High School is being upgraded to provide new permanent teaching spaces and core facilities, as well as vocational education (VET) facilities. The upgrade will provide new and refurbished learning spaces, a new library, a new senior learning environment, a new, larger capacity school support unit, VET facilities for industry standard courses in Construction, Hospitality and Primary Industries, Music, Business Services, Sports Coaching and the relocation and enhancement of Performing Arts facilities and learning spaces.

Progress Update

The Vocational Education and Training (VET) Buildings 1 (Technology and Applied Studies and Construction), 2 (Performing Arts), and 3 (Hospitality and Business Centre) are complete and are being used by students and teachers.

Next steps

During the summer school holidays we will continue to work on the Agriculture shed and glasshouse, along with the covered walkway link from Administration to VET 1 and Building O, which is a store shed. These are expected to be completed and ready for use in Term 2 of 2024.

Construction of the shared waste facility and carpark is set to begin in early 2024. Additionally, efforts will be made to install the final sewer pump station at the Aquatic Centre, pending approval from the Council.

Working hours

The site will be closed between Friday 22 December 2023 and Tuesday 2 January 2024. Construction will restart from Wednesday 3 January 2024 and take place within the approved construction hours of 7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am to 1 pm on Saturdays. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays, unless otherwise advised.

The School Infrastructure NSW office will be closed from 5 pm Friday 22 December 2023 to 9 am Monday 8 January 2024, inclusive.
