Investing in our schools

We are upgrading Tweed River High School to provide modern facilities and improve educational outcomes for the school community. The delivery of these projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students.

Project overview

Tweed River High School is being upgraded to provide new permanent teaching spaces and core facilities, as well as vocational education (VET) facilities. The upgrade will provide new and refurbished learning spaces, a new library, a new senior learning environment, a new, larger capacity school support unit, VET facilities for industry standard courses in Construction, Hospitality and Primary Industries, Music, Business Services, Sports Coaching and the relocation and enhancement of Performing Arts facilities and learning spaces.

Progress Update

Vocational Education and Training (VET) Building 1, which includes the Technology and Applied Studies (TAS) and Construction workshop, along with a new maker space, are now ready for students and teachers' day 1, term 4 2023. This building includes practical teaching spaces with new construction machinery, a covered outdoor construction area, a design and planning room with 3D printers and laser cutter, staff study and new landscaped areas.

Next steps

The next two VET buildings (VET 2 – Performing Arts and VET 3 – Hospitality and Business Centre) will be handed over **before the end of term 4, 2023.**
