Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a historic \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

Tweed River High School is being upgraded to provide new permanent teaching spaces and core facilities, as well as vocational education (VET) facilities. The upgrade will provide new and refurbished learning spaces, a new library, a new senior learning environment, a new, larger capacity school support unit, VET facilities for industry standard courses in Construction, Hospitality and Primary Industries, Music, Business Services, Sports Coaching and the relocation and enhancement of Performing Arts facilities and learning spaces.

Progress Update

Over the summer break we completed the foundations of the new agricultural buildings and are now progressing with structural steel, brickwork and cladding install. The covered walkway between the new administration building and the VET building 1 has commenced.

Upgrades to the carpark and new shared waste facilities continue with practical completion anticipated for late March.

Next steps

We are waiting on approval from the Council before we can commence installation of the final sewer pump station.

The final stages of work are due to be complete and operational in Term 2 2024.
