## Project update | February 2024

### Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a historic \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

### Project overview

Tweed River High School is being upgraded to provide new permanent teaching spaces and core facilities, as well as Vocational Education and Training (VET) Facilities. The upgrade will provide new and refurbished learning spaces, a new library, a new senior learning environment, a new, larger capacity school support unit, VET facilities for industry standard courses in Construction, Hospitality and Primary Industries, Music, Business Services, Sports Coaching and the relocation and enhancement of Performing Arts facilities and learning spaces.

### Progress Update

The new agricultural building and glass house are almost complete and will be ready for handover late May.

Upgrades to the carpark and new shared waste facilities are now practically complete and nearing formal handover late May.

The Connecting to Country NAIDOC garden located in front of the performance building has been planted with signage expected to be completed in July.

A new covered walkway has been constructed along building A and will be handed over in late May.

### Next steps

The final stages of work outlined above are due to be complete and operational in Term 2 2024.

## Working hours

Approved construction hours are 7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am to 1 pm on Saturdays. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays, unless otherwise advised.
