Tweed River High School Works notification

Tweed River High School is being upgraded to provide new permanent teaching spaces and core facilities. This includes the refurbishment and extension of Block K to provide a new, larger capacity support unit for the school.

Site establishment

From Monday 3 May 2021, weather permitting, work will commence to establish the site compound and works area for the refurbishment and extension of Block K. Activities will include:

- Installation of temporary site fencing and tree protection zones
- Installation of the site office and site amenities
- Creation of a carpark for deliveries and subcontractors
- Locating and disconnecting sewer, water, gas and electrical services to enable demolition and refurbishment to commence.

Internal refurbishment

From 6 May 2021, weather permitting, work will commence on the internal refurbishment of Block K. This work is expected to be completed by July 2021, and activities will include:

- Demolition of internal walls, floor coverings, windows and doors and construction of the new internal room layout
- Installation of services such as electrical, data, water, and air conditioning
- Application of new paint and floor coverings.

Working hours

Standard project working hours will be 7:00am to 5:00pm Monday to Friday, and 8:00am to 1:00pm on Saturdays. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.

Safety and traffic management

Vehicle access to the Block K site compound and works area will be via the council carpark to the east of the school.

Contractors will ensure that deliveries are conducted safely and spotters will be used as required to monitor heavy vehicle movements. All construction vehicles will obey speed limits and give way to pedestrians. Contractors will park in a carpark within the works area.

Work health, safety and environmental inspections will be undertaken by the site supervisor weekly to ensure work is being carried out safely and to address any specific matters such as management of noise and dust.
