## Tweed River High School Works notification

Tweed River High School is being upgraded to provide new and refurbished teaching spaces, core facilities and vocational education and training (VET) facilities.

The scope of work includes new and refurbished learning spaces, a new library, new senior learning environment, a new larger capacity school support unit, and new VET learning spaces and facilities for construction, hospitality and agriculture.

## Works to existing school hall

From Tuesday 6 April 2021 and throughout the 2021 Term 1 holiday period, our contractors will be carrying out internal works within the existing school hall. This work is required to enable the Creative and Performing Arts faculty and students to move out of K Block which is being extended and refurbished to provide a new, larger capacity school support unit.

Work within the hall will include:


- Constructing a temporary teaching and learning space, music practise rooms and instrument storage.
- Installation of new ceiling and exhaust fans.
- Installation of new lighting and adjustments to existing lighting to suit new internal layout.

Temporary fencing will be installed around the hall to secure the area and prevent public access. Fencing will be removed prior to the start of Term 2.

Access to the site will be restricted, with spotters guiding deliveries and vehicle access through gates (see map).

Standard work hours will apply - 7:00am to 5:30pm, Monday to Friday and 8:00am to 1:00pm on Saturdays.
