Upcoming maintenance works to repair a cracked window pane at Tweed River High School will require working with asbestos containing material. Testing conducted by an independent hygienist has confirmed that the putty holding the glass in place contains asbestos. If undisturbed the material is not a safety risk.

The work to replace the window will be completed outside of school hours and in accordance with the Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan and SafeWork NSW regulations. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors, and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

Testing will be completed to ensure the area has been fully remediated. The school will receive a clearance certificate before the area is open to students and staff. We will keep you informed if further material is found which requires removal.

The health, safety, and well-being of the school and the local community is our highest priority. Please be assured that the removal of this material will not pose a risk to the local community.
