

Tweed River High School

Works notification

Tweed River High school is being upgraded to provide new permanent teaching spaces and core facilities, as well as new specialist vocational education facilities.

Remediation activities

During planned hazardous material testing as part of upgrade works at Tweed River High School, potential asbestos containing material was located around the poultry shed. The area has been isolated and testing will be conducted by an independent hygienist to confirm the exact nature of the material.

This area will be remediated in accordance with the Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan and SafeWork NSW regulations. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors, and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

All remediation works will be conducted outside of school hours and testing will be completed to ensure the area has been fully remediated. The school will receive a clearance certificate before the area is open to students and staff.

Safety is the number one priority for School Infrastructure NSW and we are following all health advice in relation to construction sites. The health, safety, and well-being of the school and the local community is our highest priority and we will continue to keep the community updated.
