

Ulladulla Public School upgrade

Works notification | 7 October 2025

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, a project is underway to upgrade Ulladulla Public School to expand the school capacity.

Upcoming site establishment works

In preparation for construction of the Ulladulla Public School upgrade, site establishment and ground works will begin on Monday 20 October. There will be increased vehicle movement along Green Street during these initial works.

Site establishment works will take approximately 2 weeks and will include:

- installing temporary fencing around the construction site perimeter
- setting up site office sheds and facilities for the workers including walkways and amenities
- establishing temporary power and water supply to the site.

Start of construction works

Following site establishment, major construction works on the public school upgrade will begin. The following key construction activities are expected from 20 October 2025:

- frequent delivery of construction materials
- earthworks, piling, and structural works in preparation for concrete pours
- the installation of cables, pipes and other essential services.

Construction site access to the work zone will be via a dedicated gate on Green Street. Main Access to Ulladulla Public School will be from Green Street with the bus bay, pedestrian entry and the kiss and drop remaining. Refer to the map on the next page for location details.

Traffic control will be in place as required to manage pedestrian and vehicle movements near the construction access gates. Noise and vibration impacts are expected during some construction activities which will be managed in accordance with management plans.

Working hours

Standard construction works will take place from Monday to Friday from 7 am to 6 pm and 8 am to 1 pm on Saturdays. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays unless otherwise advised. Construction deliveries and movements will be scheduled outside of peak times for at the start and finish of each school day.

Managing construction impacts
