Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$8.6 billion in school infrastructure over the next 4 years, continuing its program to deliver 160 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This builds on the more than \$9.1 billion invested in projects delivered since 2017, a program of \$17.7 billion in public education infrastructure.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

In January 2019, a fire destroyed a building at Wagga Wagga Public School. A new facility is being built to replace the 6 classrooms that were lost in the fire. The new building will connect to adjacent buildings and include 6 modern learning spaces, 2 staff offices, new toilet facilities and a new lift.

Progress summary

Works are progressing onsite. The concrete slab has been poured for the ground floor, and the tilt panel external walls have been poured and lifted into place. Bricklaying to stairwell 1 and 2 is completed and the structural steel has been delivered.

Next steps

During Term 3, works will start on the retaining wall along Johnston Street and scaffolding will be installed around the perimeter of Building D. Works to install the steel structure to form the backbone of the building will also start. The external light steel framing on the ground floor will begin and the shade structure over the new playground will be installed.
