Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Waitara Public School

A project is underway to upgrade Waitara Public School. The project will deliver:

- 37 new permanent classrooms
- a new hall and canteen
- new staff and administration facilities
- upgraded core facilities, including increased library space.

Works on site take place:

7am to 5pm – Monday to Saturday No work takes place on Sundays or public holidays.

Progress summary

Construction is continuing on site with concrete pours completed to all levels. The roof sheeting and internal and external wall framing are underway.

- Scaffolding removal
- Air conditioning Installation
- Internal finishing works
