

Frequently asked questions

What is being delivered in the upgrade at Wamberal Public School?

The upgrade includes permanent teaching spaces for 15 classrooms and upgraded existing facilities including:

- administration building
- student amenities
- staff amenities and facilities
- front staff carpark.

Further work will be done throughout Term 1 to finish the upgrades to the:

- western carpark and staff carpark
- school hall

Which classes are being relocated?

The new classrooms are fully operational and students will move into them on 29 January 2020. Teachers will provide students with more information when they return to school.

Will there be any changes to the school entrances?

The main school entrance is at Lea Avenue. This is the only entrance that will be open during school operational hours.

The entrance on Aldinga Drive is only operational between:

- 7:00am and 9:30am
- 3:30pm to 4:30pm

Will there be any changes to the Out of School Hours Care?

No, it will continue to operate as normal.

When will the demountables be removed?

Five demountable buildings were removed in late 2019. It is anticipated that the five remaining demountables will be removed in Term 1.



Will there be any changes to parking, staff parking, Kiss and Drop area or the bus stop?

The front carpark has been upgraded to enable additional car spaces for staff and visitors including additional accessibility car parks.

The western carpark will be upgraded by April 2020 to provide secure car parking access for staff.

There are no changes to the bus stop or speed zones.
