Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Wangi Wangi Public School

A project is underway to upgrade Wangi Wangi Public School to cater for projected enrolment growth in the area. The project will deliver new permanent flexible and innovative learning spaces for six classes, a new canteen, new administration building, toilet facilities and amenities, and a new hall.

Progress summary

The Wangi Wangi Public School upgrade is progressing well. Early works were completed in February 2019 and construction started in May 2019 with site establishment works including removal of the existing administration demountable building and demolition of Building B and the existing canteen. Other work completed includes the refurbishment of the hall in to special programs spaces.

The project is on track to be completed in late 2020.

Summer school holiday works

Work continuing over the summer school break includes construction of the new hall, new administration building and level 1 teaching spaces.

This work will involve erection of structural steel for the new hall and first floor teaching spaces, pouring concrete for the first-floor columns for the new teaching spaces, building internal walls within the administration building, and installation of roofing on the new hall building

Frequently asked questions

What works will be completed over the holidays?

Erection of the structural steel for the communal hall and first-floor teaching spaces followed by roofing works, concrete pour of the first floor columns for the teaching space building, and internal walls within the administration building and roofing works.

What are the construction working hours?

Work will take place during standard construction hours between 7:00am and 5:00pm, Monday to Saturday. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.

Will construction take place over Christmas and New Year?

Workers will be on site on 24 December, 27 December, 30 December, and 31 December.

What safety measures will be in place?

- The safety of the school and local community is our top priority
- During construction, the contractors will follow rigorous processes to ensure the safety of students, staff, contractors, parents and other visitors to the site is maintained
- We will work closely with the School Principal to minimise any disruptions across the project
- The construction site will be fenced with full height hoarding to separate the construction from the operating school. There will be no deliveries during the peak hours in the morning and afternoon to avoid cross over of construction and school traffic.

What steps will be taken to control noise and dust impacts?

Measures are in place to minimise noise and dust impacts including:

- Hoardings have been erected around the construction zones to reduce dust and noise impacts to the community. Dust mitigation measures will be implemented during excessive dust related activities.
- A weekly forecast of upcoming construction activities allows the school and contractors to coordinate any noisy activities and minimise any disruption to the school community.

How will traffic be managed?

- A traffic control plan for the project has been implemented in consultation with the school and Council
- There will be adjustments to street parking and kiss-and-ride through the construction period
- Construction contractors will enter the site via controlled entryways and will park away from the school site to minimise impacts on traffic and parking.

How will you keep us informed?
