Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Warnervale new primary school

A project is underway to build a new primary school at 75 Warnervale Road to bring students the latest educational facilities and support the growing local community.

The school will provide new permanent innovative and flexible learning spaces and facilities for 20 classes, an administration and staff building, a multipurpose hall and performance stage, a double storey library with two special programs rooms, landscaped external play spaces and a mini sports field.

The new school will accommodate up to 460 students and the core facilities will cater for 1000 students to allow for future expansion of the school in the long term.

Progress summary

Following the recent approval of the State Significant Development Application, a design and construct contract was awarded to Richard Crookes Construction in mid-June, 2020.

Site establishment works

Site establishment works to clear and prepare the site for construction are expected to start approximately two months after the award of contract.

This will allow sufficient time for Richard Crookes Construction to progress the schematic design and obtain a construction certificate.
