## Warnervale new primary school

### Project update

#### Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

#### Warnervale new primary school

A project is underway to build an additional primary school at 75 Warnervale Road to cater for projected enrolment growth in the area. The school will provide new permanent innovative and flexible learning spaces and facilities for 20 classes, including a new hall and a new library.

The new school will accommodate up to 460 students and the core facilities will cater for 1000 students to allow for future expansion of the school in the long term.

#### Progress summary

A major milestone in planning for the new Warnervale primary school has been reached with the State Significant Development Application (SSDA) being lodged with the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE).

The SSDA Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) will be on public exhibition from late September for a minimum of 28 days, and can be viewed via DPIE's online Major Projects Planning Portal at: [www.planningportal.nsw.gov.au/major-projects/](http://www.planningportal.nsw.gov.au/major-projects/)
