Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

Wauchope Public School

An upgrade is underway for Wauchope Public School. The project will deliver a new two storey building, which provides 13 new permanent learning spaces.

This will increase the school's enrolment capacity to approximately 750 students.

The design of the new classrooms will incorporate future-focused learning to support the needs of Wauchope students and their community, and provide a learning-centred approach to education.

Progress summary

The construction of the new two storey building with 13 learning spaces is near completion.

Summer school holiday works

The installation of the lift in the new learning building will be completed over the holidays.

Construction work will continue with some landscaping over the school holidays.

Construction work will take place Monday to Saturday, 7:00am to 6:00pm. No work will take place on Sundays or Public Holidays.

Frequently asked questions

What works will be completed over the holidays?

The lift installation in the new learning building will be completed over the holidays.

Construction work will continue with some landscaping over the school holidays.

What are the construction working hours?

Construction hours over the summer break will be as per the standard hours:

Monday to Saturday, 7:00am to 6:00pm.

No work will be undertaken on Sunday or on public holidays.

Will construction take place over Christmas and New Year?

No work will be undertaken on Sunday or on public holidays.

What safety measures will be in place?

The health and safety of the community is our highest priority. Temporary fencing has been erected around the construction site to secure the area and prevent public access.

When will the demountable classrooms be removed?

The demountable classrooms will be removed early next year.

What steps will be taken to control noise and dust impacts?

Noise and dust control measures will be implemented in accordance with planning approval requirements.

Hoarding and shade cloth have been erected to reduce noise and dust impacts on the school and local residents. Dust from construction works will be hosed down as required.

How will traffic be managed?

Traffic management will be in place where required for the safety of students, staff, the local community and workers.

Traffic controllers will be used where required to manage entry and exit of vehicles to and from the construction site. Vehicles will give way to pedestrians at all times.
