Summer holidays works notification | December 2022

A project is underway to redevelop Wee Waa High School. The project will deliver new learning spaces, modern core facilities including a library and multipurpose hall, a new agricultural and environment centre, sports fields and sports courts as well as a new Indigenous Cultural Centre.

Upcoming works: Potholing investigations from 3 January 2023

From the week beginning on Tuesday 3 January 2023, potholing investigation will begin along George Street, Charles Street and Mitchell Street in preparation for the next stage of works to begin.

Potholing involves the drilling of small shallow holes of approximately 20 to 30 cm wide on the surface of the road to confirm the location of utility lines and any other existing structures that may be within the road.

A truck with a mounted surveying and detection equipment will be used to conduct the work. Traffic control personnel will guide traffic during works and no streets will be closed.

Tree removal works

Throughout January, approximately 12 trees will be removed from the existing site boundary as part of the main works of the project, under the approved planning consent. All works will be guided by a qualified arborist and in line with the project's Arborist Assessment report. We recognise the important role that trees play on the school site and we will preserve as many as possible as part of the project. Removed trees will be replaced and additional trees will be planted throughout the site.
