

Wee Waa High School

Works notification

12 July 2022

A project is underway to redevelop Wee Waa High School. The project will deliver new learning spaces, modern core facilities including a library and multipurpose hall, a new agricultural and environment centre, sports fields and sports courts as well as a new Indigenous Cultural Centre.

Site establishment beginning Monday 18 July

From Monday 18 July 2022, works will start on site of the Wee Waa High School site on Mitchell Street to establish a construction site mobilisation for the early works on site excavation, levelling and drainage. This includes:

- installation of fencing and shade cloth around the perimeter of the construction site to secure the area, preventing public access and creating a secure barrier from existing school grounds
- installation of work sheds, toilets and meeting rooms
- establishment of erosion and sediment controls.

Noise, vibration and dust control measures

Noise and dust control measures will be implemented in accordance with the approved Review of Environmental Factors (REF).

Secure fencing and shade cloth will be installed to reduce noise and dust impacts on the local residents. Dust from construction works will be hosed down as required and monitored in conditions of high wind to mitigate high levels of dust being created. Any material that is required to be stockpiled will be covered to prevent any material becoming airborne.

Traffic and pedestrian impacts

The main vehicle entrance for construction traffic will be through a temporary vehicle entry off Charles Street. A separate pedestrian access for authorised workers will be available via a temporary gate from Mitchell Street. See map overleaf.

A Construction Pedestrian and Traffic Management Plan will be in place to ensure the safety of the community and workers at all times. Traffic controllers will be used when required to manage entry and exit of vehicles to and from the construction site. Vehicles will give way to pedestrians at all times.

At times, to facilitate deliveries, there might be partial or full road closures of the southbound Charles Street and northbound George Street. In these cases, signage, barriers and traffic controllers will be used to direct traffic and pedestrian travel.
