Works notification

A project is underway to redevelop Wee Waa High School. The project will deliver new learning spaces and modern core facilities including a library and multipurpose hall, a new agricultural and environment centre, sports fields and sports courts as well as a new Indigenous Cultural Centre.

Update on remediation works

Further to the notification shared on 31 August, remediation works at the site of the new high school was not able to take place on Monday 5 September and Tuesday 6 September due to wet weather.

We are expecting to undertake the remediation work during the week beginning **Monday 12 September between 7 am and 6 pm** weather permitting.

Air monitoring will be in place throughout the works in accordance with the advice of the independent hygienist. The area is cordoned off and is within the construction site, remaining inaccessible to the community.

Testing will be completed to ensure the area has been fully remediated. The construction contractor will receive a clearance certificate prior to recommencing works in this area.

The area will be remediated in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations, the Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan, and the project's hazardous material management protocols. All work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors, and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines, and based on assessment of site context and conditions.

The health, safety, and well-being of the school and the local community is our highest priority and we will continue to keep the community updated.
