

Wee Waa High School upgrade

Works notification | May 2023

A project is underway to redevelop Wee Waa High School. The project will deliver new learning spaces, modern core facilities including a library and multipurpose hall, a new agricultural and environment centre, sports fields and sports courts as well as a new Indigenous Cultural Centre.

Full road closure- Excavation and stormwater drainage along Charles Street

Further to the information shared in the [March 2023 project update](#), drainage works along Charles Street have now been approved and are scheduled to begin from Tuesday 16 May 2023.

These works include excavating pits along Charles Street to access stormwater drainpipes. The current stormwater drainpipes will be removed and replaced during the works to increase the capacity of the stormwater infrastructure from the new school.

To complete these works, a road closure of Charles Street between Mitchell Street and Boundary Street will be required and access to the road will be restricted to residents. Works are expected to take approximately 26 weeks to complete.

A traffic management plan will be in place during the works to support the safe access of residents, this includes:

- A 'no through traffic- resident only' sign and barrier placed at each side of Charles Street
- Road closed signs at either side of Charles Street and 50 metres from the intersections at Mitchell Street and Boundary Street.
- During work hours, residents will be escorted through the work site by traffic control personnel
- After work hours, the barrier will be moved to provide access for residents.
