Project update | November 2023

Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a historic \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education. The 2023-24 Budget committed funding to continue work on the permanent Wee Waa High School.

Project overview

A project is underway to redevelop Wee Waa High School. The project will deliver new learning spaces, modern core facilities, including a library and multipurpose hall, a new agricultural and environment centre, sports fields and sports courts, as well as a new Indigenous Cultural Centre.

Progress update

Works are progressing at the site of the Wee Waa High School redevelopment. Completed activities include:

- installing external cladding and walls
- fitting of internal services such as drainage, water, and electrical connections
- installation of doors and windows
- pouring concrete walkways between the buildings
- installation of a lift and balustrades throughout the school.

Stormwater upgrade works delivered outside of the school site along Charles and George Streets have continued. These include:

- installing most of the stormwater drainage pipes beneath Charles Street
- starting the backfilling of the road
- site preparation and excavation for the new levee stormwater pump to be fitted.

Construction activities over the next 3 months will include:

- installing the schools' internal walls and ceilings
- put in place internal fittings like flooring, painting, taps, and toilets
- landscaping inside the school grounds
- ongoing stormwater upgrade works along Charles Street.

Agricultural site update

The department has started reviewing the feasibility of the proposed plan to maintain the existing school site solely for the purpose of agricultural studies. This could mean a change to the proposed scope for the agricultural facilities at the school site located on Purcell Avenue.

We are consulting with the school to ensure that the required operational needs for the school's existing agricultural program are at the forefront of any changes. We will keep the community updated with further information as planning progresses.
