Wee Waa High School Project update | September 2024



Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

The project to redevelop Wee Waa High School has delivered new classrooms, core facilities, including a library, canteen and multipurpose hall, a new agricultural and environment centre, sports fields and sports courts, as well as a new Indigenous Cultural Centre. The project will also provide upgrades to the school's agricultural grounds located in Purcell Avenue.

Progress update and next steps

Throughout Term 3, students have been learning from their new facilities while external works to complete the sports field have continued, with the installation of the remaining turf and new goal posts for the new school oval, these works are now complete. Some works outside of the school grounds will continue over the coming months, however these will not impact school operations.

We are close to confirming a contractor to undertake the works required to upgrade the school's agricultural site on Purcell Avenue. We expect that construction at the agricultural site will begin early next term.

We have begun the documentation required to procure a demolition contractor to undertake demolition of the existing buildings at the old high school.

The community will be notified once the contractor is on board and timelines for demolition starting.

We will work with the school to minimise any impact to student learning during this stage of the project.
