

Wee Waa High School upgrade

Works notification | 2 February 2023

A project is underway to redevelop Wee Waa High School. The project will deliver new learning spaces, modern core facilities including a library and multipurpose hall, a new agricultural and environment centre, sports fields and sports courts as well as a new Indigenous Cultural Centre.

Installation of new footpath and kerbside blisters along Mitchell Street.

Public domain works will begin on Mitchell Street from Tuesday 6 February. These works include the construction of a new footpath and installation of new kerb side blisters. The works are expected to take approximately 6 weeks to complete, and some impact to surrounding traffic is expected. During this time, there will be no pedestrian access on the side of the new footpath, however pedestrians will be able to use the footpath on the opposite side of Mitchell Street.

For the construction of the new footpath and kerbside blister installation, the building contractor will excavate, level and prepare the site prior to pouring the concrete. It is expected that at times during these works, a partial lane closure will be required. When required, a traffic management plan will be in place to assist in managing traffic and pedestrians.

The works area will be cordoned off with barriers and appropriate signage displayed.
