Wee Waa High School Works notification | 21 May 2025

A project to redevelop Wee Waa High School has delivered new classrooms, core facilities including a library, canteen and multipurpose hall, a new agricultural and environment centre, sports fields and sports courts, as well as a new Indigenous Cultural Centre.

The project provided upgrades to the school's agricultural grounds located in Purcell Avenue.

Testing for suspected mould

On Friday 16 May, a hygienist attended the school to test for suspected mould in the administration building's kitchenette.

Testing was undertaken and the area has been closed to staff and students while we await results, which are expected by Thursday 22 May. If the results confirm the presence of mould, the area will be remediated and made safe before being reopened.

On Monday 19 May, a leaking tap was found inside a cupboard in the science lab. The area was immediately closed due to concerns that mould could form, and a hygienist will attend site today, Wednesday 21 May, to investigate further.

As a further precaution, a thorough review will be undertaken throughout all areas of the school starting from Friday 23 May. This review will include all buildings and internal rooms as well as external playing facilities and the oval. We will also revisit areas that were previously cleared to make sure they are still clear of mould.

In addition, we will use thermal imaging technology to scan the building to check for any areas of moisture. We will also be consulting with an independent expert for the purpose of quality assurance.

After the review we will look at the results and create a plan for immediate action. We will share this plan with the school and wider community as soon as it is known.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community is our highest priority. Please rest assured that we are committed to maintaining a clean and healthy school environment and will continue to monitor the situation carefully.
