Works notification | 18 August 2023

Changes to ongoing lane and roundabout impacts on Burroway Road

The next stage of works to deliver Wentworth Point new high school involves laying approximately 90 metres of inground pipework to install critical water and wastewater infrastructure for the new high school.

Due to operational needs, the work, previously notified on 14 July 2023 is now occurring in reverse order, with Phase 2 being completed before Phase 1. Work is now moving into the roundabout for approximately three weeks.

This work involves temporary impacts and partial road closures to a section of Burroway Road and changes to the regular use of the roundabout on Burroway Road. During construction hours only, Monday to Friday between 7am and 6pm. During these times vehicles will be unable to make U-turns from some directions and one of the two parking/drop off spaces outside the school on Burroway Road will not be in use.

Please be assured that access to Burroway Road and Wentworth Place will remain open at all times.

Please refer to the map over the page showing the temporary disruptions to the roundabout and road. Work is expected to be complete by the end of September, ahead of original schedule. If there are any major weather impacts affecting this end date, we will advise the community, and the work will be finished as soon as possible.

To provide continuous vehicle access and minimise the impact, work will occur in smaller sections. At the start of each shift the construction zone and traffic control will be set up to control or close a section of the road.

Outside of the construction hours the trenches will be covered with road plates allowing the road to return to normal function.

Across the work area, traffic management will be in place to divert traffic safely around the road closures and existing pedestrian closures. This includes dedicated traffic controllers during work hours, signage and barriers around the work.

There may be some additional noise created during this work from the concrete cutting of the road, but live noise monitoring equipment will be in place to ensure works are within the allowable noise range.

Gas network works

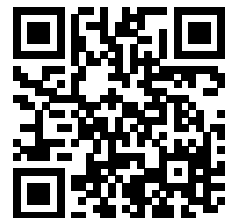

The roundabout will temporarily become a T-intersection during work hours and cannot be used for U-turns during construction hours. This work is expected to take approximately 3 weeks.

Please note: one of the two parking/drop off spaces outside Wentworth Point Public School (on the left of the signage in the diagram below) will be shut for the duration of the works to comply with the Traffic Management Control Plan for the works.
